

October 11, 2007, Special Council Meeting

Administration: Approve Ordinance to Extend Loan Guaranty  
Mayor's Report: Commended Public Works Department  
Manager's Report: District Magistrate Issued Favorable Decision

A special meeting of the Clarion Borough Council was held on October 11, 2007, in the Borough Offices. President Wilshire called the meeting to order at 8:04 a.m. Members present included Mr. Herman, Ms. Vavrek, Ms. Moore and President Wilshire. Mr. Zerfoss, Ms. Leonard, and Mr. German were absent. Mayor Stroup and Nancy Freenock were also present.

Administration

President Wilshire indicated that the reason for the meeting was to approve Ordinance No. 2007-746 which is the extension of the loan guaranty given to First United National Bank to secure a loan made by the bank to the Clarion Area Authority in the amount of \$900,000. The guaranty would be extended for an additional six-month period.

Mr. Herman made a motion the Council adopt Ordinance No. 2007-746. The motion was seconded by Ms. Moore. The motion carried with a vote of four yea.

Mayor's Report

The Mayor commended the Public Works Department for their work during ALF. The streets were very clean after the major festival events. The Mayor has received no bad reports concerning the event.

Manager's Report

Ms. Freenock stated that a decision was made by District Magistrate Quinn in favor of the Borough in the case Clarion Borough v. Ian Griffin.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on a motion made by Mr. Herman and seconded by Ms. Vavrek, the meeting was adjourned at 8:14 am.
